FAKO SDO CAUTIONS LAND GRABBERS



The Senior Divisional Officer (SDO) for Fako, Mr. Chaibou has pledged full support to the Management of the CDC to crack down on illegal encroachers of the CDC leasehold lands. He made the statement during a working session of his contact tour to the CDC Head Office on September 22, 2022. The SDO was received by the General Manager, Mr. Franklin Ngoni Njie and a cross section of Top Management Staff. After brief introductions, the GM painted a picture of the current

state of affairs in the CDC. Citing persistent encroachments on the CDC water catchment area in the Bota Nursery, the GM expressed worry over serious health hazard to CDC workers and the local community especially at this time when the fight against cholera outbreak is at its peak.

During exchanges, the SDO cautioned illegal land grabbers to desist from using unorthodox means to acquire CDC lands. He stated vehemently that "the procedure to acquire land shall strictly

be adhered to", stressing that "no one will grab land illegally in Fako". The General Manager also recalled that CDC holds a special place in the hearts of many Cameroonians through active presence within the local communities and is presently home to thousands of Internally Displaced persons

The SDO promised to accompany the Management of the CDC surmount its key challenge which is that of security.
