Speaking to the PLANTER, the Regional Coordinator, Doctor Mabongo Daniel revealed that their mission is to assess the GICAM project in the CDC, evaluate Occupational Health and Safety and ascertain whether the focal points were aware of their tasks and job descriptions. Thereafter, the entire Committee shall go to the field to assess implementation of planned activities by GICAM with focus on preventive measures concerning (3) three key diseases to wit: HIV, Malaria and Tuberculosis. He further revealed that they shall equally assess health and safety challenges faced by CDC workers in the execution of their functions and factor same in their action plans. The CDC Coordinator for Occupational Health and Safety Doctor Nganje Samuel was optimistic that their recommendations are pivotal to the planning process with a view to ensuring that the health and safety of CDC workers remain a priority.
